Liver Cancer Talk at Raffles Town Club

Johns Hopkins Singapore International Medical Centre has organized a public education health talk for the members of the Raffles Town Club on the 29th of September evening at 7.30pm. The talk was conducted by Dr Akhil Chopra, an oncology consultant of the Centre. The event was organized for the members of the Raffles Town Club at the Private Lounge area as part of Johns Hopkins Singapore International Medical Centre's efforts to interact with the local community and to address some of the questions and perceptions regarding liver cancer and other forms of related cancer. A total number of 15 people attended the health talk, mainly made up of men and women in their 50s and 60s who were eager to know more about liver cancer and cancer disease in general. The event was initially scheduled to end at 8.30pm, however some of the participants were very eager to approach Dr Chopra to get your questions answered during the Q&A session and the event was extended and ended at 9.15pm. Overall, the event was well received by the attendees.

Dr Akhil Chopra is American board certified in Internal Medicine as well as in Hematology/Medical oncology. Dr. Chopra specializes in malignant hematology including lymphomas and B-cell malignancies as well as in thoracic and gastrointestinal malignancies.
